

Anderson School District One Free Summer Meal Program

The regular grab-and-go meals provided by the District will end on Thursday, June 4. This includes all bus delivery meals. The Summer Feeding Program begins on Monday, June 8, 2020, and ends on August 6, 2020, at the following times and USDA approved locations:

West Pelzer Elementary School Monday-Thursday 11:30 am -1:00 pm (location will be closed Fridays)
10 West Stewart Street
West Pelzer, SC 29669

Mineral Springs Park Monday-Thursday 11:30 am -1:00 pm (location will be closed Fridays)
Center Street
Williamston, SC 29697

All children 18 years old or younger are eligible for meals at no charge. Lunch and the next day's breakfast will be available Monday-Thursday. The Summer Feeding Program is only approved for geographical areas of need as determined by the USDA.

Because of COVID-19 social distancing requirements, meals will only be provided on a to-go basis through a drive up line (just as they are currently). There will be no need for parents to exit their vehicles to obtain their meals. USDA has provided flexibility to allow the distribution of meals to adults to take home to children who are not present. Each day the names of children who receive a meal but are not present during the pick-up will need to be provided. Buses will not deliver meals during the Summer Feeding Program.
